



Dear RCP Families:

Richmond College Prep Schools will reopen for *In-Person* classrooms on **Monday, April 19, 2021** for a **minimum number of students due to social distancing requirements**. Based on our staff capacity, we will offer in-person instruction to 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 6th grade students starting **April 19, 2021**. This decision was formed based on our recent staff and parent survey along with the California Department of Public Health Guidance and Protocols, and information from Contra Costa County Public Health and related health agencies.

The California Legislation AB-86 strongly encourages schools to prioritize pupils who would benefit the most from in-person instruction and who have been identified as needing integrated supports or academic interventions, including, but not limited to, pupils with disabilities, youth in foster care, homeless youth, English language learners, pupils from low-income families, pupils without access to a computing device, software, and high-speed internet necessary to participate in online instruction, disengaged pupils, pupils with failing grades and pupils identified as needing social and mental health support.

Class Schedule

In-person instruction Monday - Thursday: Includes 3 hours of live, in-person core content instruction, 8-11am (on campus) with a 1 hour break and 3 hours of on-line instruction (students will go home between 11 and 12 to complete the on-line portion of the class). Students who will participate in in-person instruction must do so until the end of the 2020-21 school year.

Friday will be online instruction only, for all students. No in-person instruction will be provided.

Distance Learning Instruction Monday - Thursday: All distance learning students will continue to receive core content instruction online full-time at their usual schedule.
